

#### Unity in Action: American Workers' Stand Up for Union Representation by Duane Wyant

What we saw last week with the American workers' movement is exciting, and watching it unfold in front of us is amazing. We have power as long as we stand together in unity and watch VW workers stand up and now fight for what is right, and that is union representation. The VW workers voted to organize for three days; they have 4,300 hourly workers, and they passed the vote by 73%. The UAW tried to organize in Chattanooga back in 2019 and 2014, and they were unsuccessful. The UAW International has a lot of other companies' workers wanting to stand up, such as BMW AG, Toyota Motor Corp, and Nissan Motor Company AG. A second UAW election will be held at Mercedes Benz Group in Tuscaloosa, Alabama, from May 13th to 17th. It's a great time to be a UAW member, and the non-union workers see this, and they want bigger and better pay, working conditions, and representation. They are tired of always being pushed down and want to STAND UP now and fight. So, instead of standing on the sideline, get involved and make change for us all. Let's keep the workers' movement going. Come out to our local union meeting in May on the 11th at 9 AM.




