

Re: 2025 UAW Stellantis Profit Sharing

Greetings, UAW Stellantis Family,

Stellantis announced their 2024 average profit-sharing numbers today, averaging \$3,780 per member. While disappointing, the results are not surprising. Former CEO Carlos Tavares's mismanagement of this company is reflected in this announcement. Under Tavares, sales plummeted, and vehicle inventories skyrocketed. This mismanagement was why we launched our Keep the Promise campaign, and we would like to thank all UAW members for standing strong and helping remove this destructive CEO.

What is not reflected in these financial results is the hard work and dedication of the Stellantis UAW members who, despite many obstacles placed in front of them every day, produce world class products that we can all be proud of. The 2024 results are dismal, and 2025 may be challenging given that the damage done to this company will take time to correct. UAW members stand ready to once again build the products that customers want, at the quality levels we expect, and at a reasonable price. If the new management team takes this direction, we look forward to working with them where possible to build back this company for our current members, customers, and our retirees.

The payout date for the for the 2024 Profit Sharing amount will be March 7, 2025. The multiplier is tentatively set at \$1.76 per compensated as described in Exhibit F, Profit Sharing Plan. Again, we would like to acknowledge the hard work and dedication of the UAW Stellantis workforce.



TAP UPDATE

Scholarship for Dependent Children Application Window Opening November 25, 2024

The enrollment period for the Scholarship for Dependent Children program opens on November 25, 2024, and runs through March 28, 2025.

All eligible members may submit signed applications to their **Local TAP Representative** for the Program during the enrollment period for courses successfully completed during the **2024** school year.

All signed applications and supporting documentation must be submitted to your **Local Tap Representative** to be received by the National TAP Office no later than **April 4, 2025.** Late submissions will not be accepted. Any applications submitted directly to the National TAP office will be returned to sender.

Please note: There will be three (3) disbursement payments beginning after the March 25th submission deadline to the National TAP Office.

The payments will be disbursed upon first in, first out completed and approved applications. The exact dates are yet to be determined but will be communicated when available. Please refer to the SFDC guidelines to avoid delays in approving your SFDC application.

Enrollment Period: November 25, 2024 - March 28, 2025




