

FREEDOM DAY

JUNE 19

Juneteenth, observed annually on June 19th, commemorates the emancipation of enslaved African Americans in the United States. The holiday marks a significant milestone in American history and is a time for reflection, celebration, and education.

The origins of Juneteenth date back to June 19, 1865, when Union General Gordon Granger arrived in Galveston, Texas, and announced the end of slavery, two and a half years after President Abraham Lincoln's Emancipation Proclamation. This delayed enforcement of the proclamation meant that over 250,000 enslaved people in Texas were unaware of their freedom until that day.

Juneteenth, also known as Freedom Day or Emancipation Day, has been celebrated for over 150 years, predominantly in African American communities.
