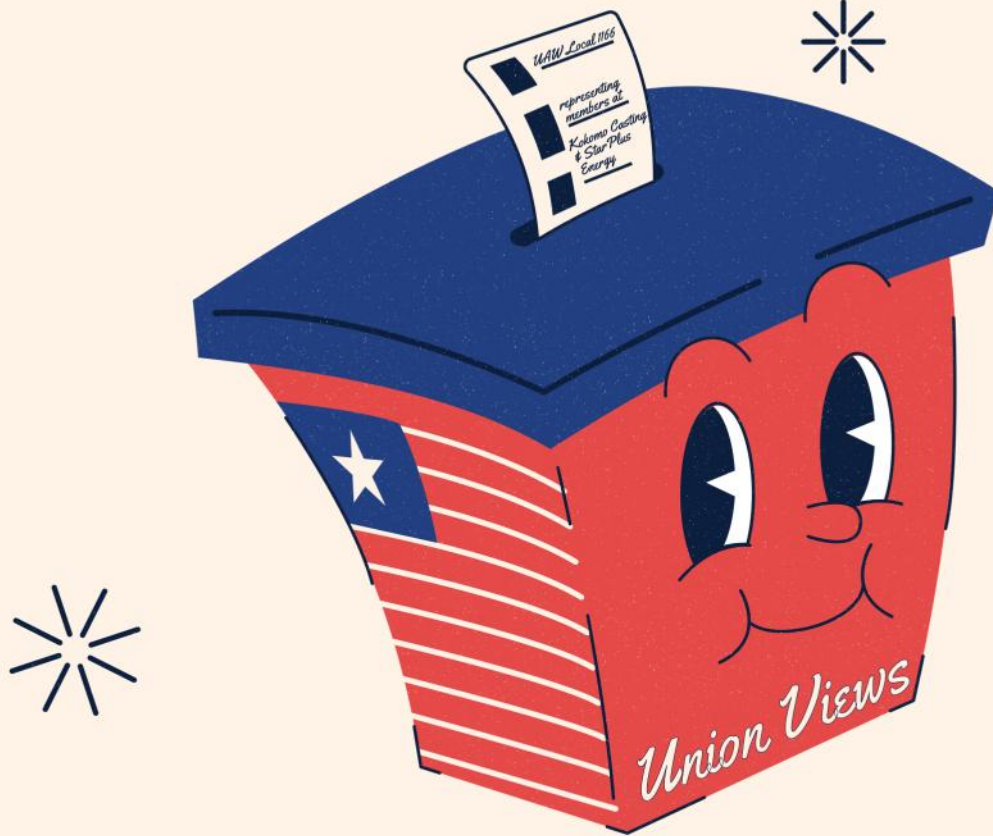

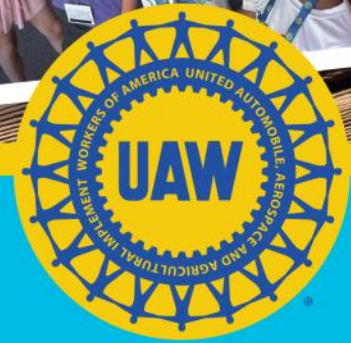

This institute transforms committed union members into skilled labor movement leaders ready to build union power from the inside out. Three focused tracks offer hands-on training for rank-and-file members and local leaders who want to step up their involvement or sharpen their existing skills as union advocates.

New Activists Track: For newer UAW members or those just now getting involved, this track will help you find your path and develop skills to take action that makes a difference!

Internal Mobilizing Track: Ready to energize your membership and increase engagement throughout your local? This track gives you the tools to grow solidarity and build collective power.

External Organizing Track: Whether you're curious about organizing or already part of an Organizing Committee, this track provides a roadmap for those passionate about bringing new workers into the movement.

ELIGIBILITY TO ATTEND

This institute is open to any UAW member in good standing who wants to begin or deepen their union involvement. Whether new or experienced, delegates will gain practical skills and strategies to strengthen our union for the fights ahead.

Attendance is mandatory at all sessions and is taken daily. Local unions will be responsible for the payment of all lost time.

REGISTRATION

Local unions must register their delegates by **Monday, March 9, 2026, at 4 p.m. ET**. The institute registration fee is \$75 per delegate and must be submitted by the local union online through LUIS no later than the registration deadline. Without a payment submission, delegate registration **will not** be approved. Funds will be withdrawn from local unions after online registration closes and the regional approval process is complete.

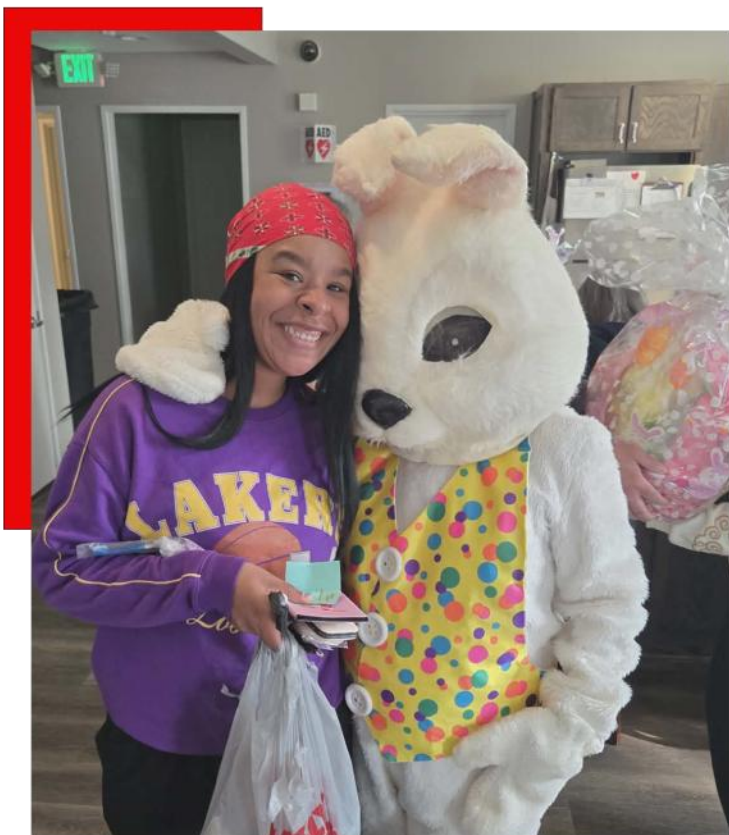

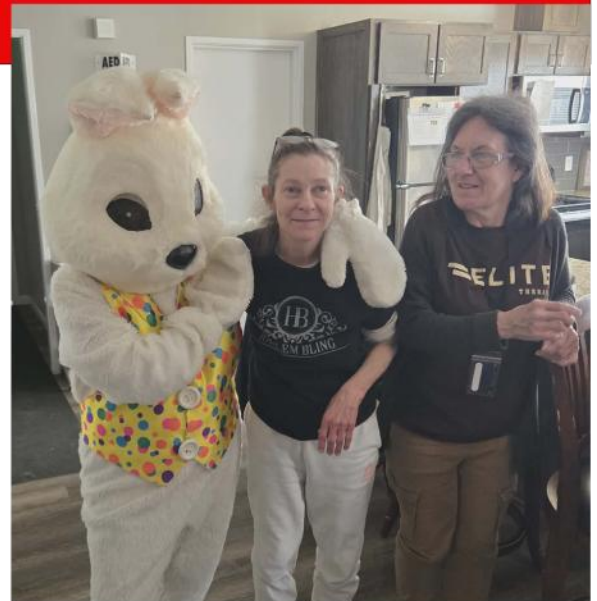

TAP UPDATE

Scholarship for Dependent Children Application Window Opening March 6, 2026

During 2023 UAW-FCA Negotiations, the Scholarship for Dependent Children (SFDC) program for members with college-aged dependent children continuing their education was successfully maintained.

The enrollment period for the Scholarship of Dependent Children program opens on **March 6, 2026, and runs through May 1, 2026.**

All eligible members may submit signed applications to their **Local TAP Representative** for the Program during the enrollment period for courses successfully completed during the **2025** school year.

All signed applications and supporting documentation must be submitted to your **Local TAP Representative** to be received by the National TAP Office **no later than May 15, 2026.** Late submissions will not be accepted. Any applications submitted directly to the National TAP office will be returned to the sender.

Please note: There will be three (3) disbursement payments beginning after the May 15th submission deadline to National TAP office. The payments will be disbursed based upon first in, first out completed and approved applications. The exact dates are yet to be determined but will be communicated when available.

- **Enrollment Period: March 6, 2026, through May 1, 2026**
 - Eligible members submit signed applications to their Local TAP Representative for the Program during the enrollment period for courses successfully completed during the 2025 school year.
- **SFDC Submission Deadline to National TAP Office: May 15, 2026**

- ▶ Forms 1099-R and W-2 will be available for download in **MyPenPay** on **February 1, 2026**
- ▶ If you do not receive your tax form(s) by **February 28, 2026**, log in to Benefit Connect and click the blue **MyPenPay** link to view and print them
- ▶ If you do not have computer access, you may request a duplicate AFTER March 15, 2026, by calling **Benefit Connect** at **1-888-409-3300**

UPDATE YOUR INFORMATION AFTER MAJOR LIFE EVENTS

If you've experienced a **marriage, divorce, or the death of a spouse**, you may need to update your pension elections.

If you had a marital status change and you wish to cancel the **Surviving Spouse Option ("SSO")** and/or make a new election, follow the applicable steps below:

If your spouse has died and you previously elected the SSO, you may cancel it and have your full monthly pension restored under the single life annuity form. The cancellation takes effect on the first day of the third month after the death certificate is received.

Your HRA Benefit increased this year to \$1000.00 per household on January 1, 2026. Debit cards are automatically reloaded so you can use your debit card for eligible expenses at a provider or pharmacy or submit for reimbursement by completing a claim form and providing documentation to WEX (claims can be submitted online or by using a paper claim form submitted using fax, email, or mail). You also can use you benefit for Medicare premium reimbursements by submitting a "Claim form". HRA Resources Online @ uawtrust.org/hra_benefit or Online account benefitslogin.wexhealth.com.
