Scholarship for Dependent Children Application **August 17, 2026 – October 16, 2026**

During 2023 UAW-FCA Negotiations, the Scholarship for Dependent Children (SFDC) program for post-secondary education for dependent children of active UAW-represented employees.

The enrollment period for the Scholarship of Dependent Children program opens on **August 17, 2026, and runs through October 16, 2026.**

All eligible members must submit signed applications to their **Local TAP Representative** for the Program during the enrollment period for courses successfully completed during the **2026** school year.

All signed applications and required supporting documentation must be submitted to your **Local TAP Representative** to be received by the National TAP Office **no later than October 30, 2026.**

- Late submissions will not be accepted. Any applications submitted directly to the National TAP office will be returned to the sender.

Please note: There will be three (3) disbursement payments beginning after the October 30th submission deadline to National TAP office. The payments will be disbursed based upon first in, first out completed and approved applications. The exact dates are yet to be determined but will be communicated when available.



Key Dates to Remember

- **August 17, 2026** – TAP Online System Opens at 12:00AM on August 17, 2026
- **October 16, 2026** – TAP Online System Closes at Midnight
- **October 30, 2026** – Deadline for Local TAP Representative to submit SFDC packages to the National TAP Department

FCA will mail 2025 IRS Forms 1099-R and W-2 by January 31, 2026, to your address on file.

- Forms 1099-R and W-2 will be available for download in **MyPenPay** on **February 1, 2026**
- If you do not receive your tax form(s) by **February 28, 2026**, log in to Benefit Connect and click the blue **MyPenPay** link to view and print them
- If you do not have computer access, you may request a duplicate AFTER March 15, 2026, by calling **Benefit Connect** at 1-888-409-3300

UPDATE YOUR INFORMATION AFTER MAJOR LIFE EVENTS

If you've experienced a **marriage, divorce, or the death of a spouse**, you may need to update your pension elections.

If you had a marital status change and you wish to cancel the **Surviving Spouse Option ("SSO")** and/or make a new election, follow the applicable steps below:

If your spouse has died and you previously elected the SSO, you may cancel it and have your full monthly pension restored under the single life annuity form. The cancellation takes effect on the first day of the third month after the death certificate is received.

We got the chance to attend the UAW Region 2B Retirees Conference in Black Lake. Our Brother of UAW 1666 President Shawn Fain addressed the conference group and talked about some of the gains the past 3 years and what will be main topics for next round of negotiations. Retirees' verbiage was already addressed, and new language has been released so that employees are now recognized as retirees when they have enough time or age and time. Current language when you were considered in tier you just quite! Not classified as retiree, didn't have a vote. Shawn addressed that and its changed prior to end of contract. Next contract getting all Retirees eligible pensions and Health Crae after retirement. and Regional Director Dave Green addressed the group on new committees and the new Regional Training Center in Ohio. Remember to vote in the upcoming 2026 UAW International Executive Elections that will include Shawn for President, Kevin Gotinsky for UAW Vice President Stellantis Division, and Dave Green UAW 2B Regional Director. Also got a lot of information from Alliance for Retired Americans for next months article.



Did You Know! The Retirees Workers Department, Retiree Chapters, and Regional Retired Workers Funds are solely funded by Retiree voluntary dues! Retired Workers Voluntary Dues Program currently has 507,131 total retirees, 241,057 currently paying dues (Per LUIS). \$3 Dues breakdown 40% UAW Retired Workers

Program, 35% Local Retirees Chapter, 25% to Regional Retired Workers Fund. You can pay your dues thru pension check \$3 Month or monthly or yearly \$36 to UAW 1166 Financial Secretary Ron DeWeese.

2026 UAW International Executive Board Direct (President, Secretary-Treasurer, Vice President Stellantis Division, Regional Director for 2B) elections (1 Member 1 Vote) are being mailed out in August 2026. Last Election in 2022 Direct Election Mailing had over 1 Million Ballots Mailed, and 106,790 were returned due to wrong address on file. Retirees, please call the UAW 1166 Union Hall to update your address, phone, or email changes. You contacting the plant to make sure your pension check keeps coming does not inform the Local of any of your changes or updates.
