Family Nurse Practitioner

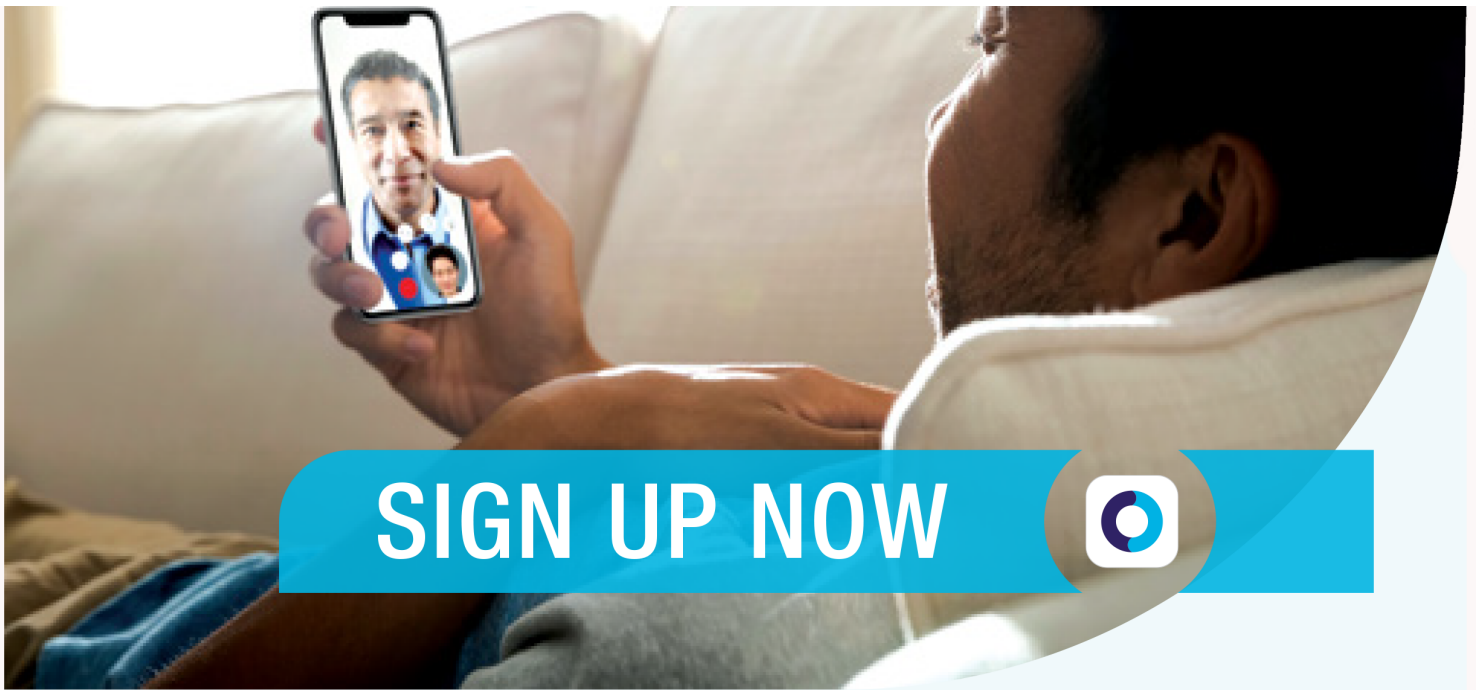
