

Brothers and Sisters,

The Company has revealed that the new M-8 and Rollback will be effective as of 2/12/2024. If you are working under a (UAP) M-8 CONDITIONAL LETTER you will not be rolled back. Many of you have seen the Highlights and asked questions since Ratification, more information has been communicated and the Local wants to make sure it is passed on as its revealed to the Leadership. There are some MAJOR changes to M-8 and it is now considered a 100% NO FAULT Policy, meaning the Company has said any missed time has to be covered with your personal time. I will list some of the most important changes and new policy guidelines. If more information or situations arise that give us even more info, we will communicate those to you as soon as possible as well.

- Absences require a 1 hour call-in (Including GR Days), Tardy's require a 30 min. call-in
- Half of your PAA and VAC. Time are required to be used Concurrent with FMLA approved time, meaning it will charge Both Personal time and FMLA Balance time together.
- HR will be involved between 7-8.5 points MGMT. will issue a single 5 Day DLO upon crossing the 7-point mark. HR will issue terminations.
- Discipline must be served within 7 Days now instead of 14
- NO FAULT, meaning the previous coverage for Emergencies involving Spouses and Children, as well as yourself are no longer covered, you must have Personal time to cover.
- Sick Leave will now take away from any approved FMLA claim. Regardless of what your claim is
 for, example...if you have 10 weeks approved FMLA for any reason, and you are off on SL for 3
 weeks due to knee surgery, you now only have 7 weeks FMLA left.
- If you have had more than 2 SL in the previous 2 years, or more than 2 pts assessed in M-8, you cannot recover points after 90 Days on-roll until you are clear. If you are at 2 pts. or under, you can recover 1 point every 90 days on-roll if you meet all conditions
- If you do not Call-In your GR Day one Hour before start of shift, you will be assessed 1 point for a no call and lose your 2nd GR Day. You will still be granted the single GR Day if you were eligible. If you have so much as .5 point assessed for a single tardy, you lose both GR Days.
- Colonoscopy requires a 5 Day advance notice or it will not be covered, 2 per life of Contract. It only covers 1 day, a prep day will have to require you to use personal time.
- All Tardy's and absences are combined for Points, no longer separate tracks.
- There are many differences in this version of M-8, if you have any further questions please see me or your Shift Steward or Committeeman and we will get the answer if we don't know it right away. Please educate yourself on the New M-8 and all of the changes, as always, keep an eye on your points and your codes. Stop by the office every few weeks and we can look them up to see if your codes aren't accurate. Please remember that this is being rolled out as a 100% NO FAULT Policy, meaning the Company is taking the stance that any time off must be covered by YOU with Personal or allotted time off under Company Policy.




ABOUT YOUR WELLBEING COORDINATOR

I have earned my Bachelor of Science degree in Health Education and Promotion from Ball State University in Muncie, IN. I then worked 3 years as a health coach working with programs such as weight management, stress management, tobacco cessation, and health improvement. I have also worked with Franciscan Health's Heart Center in Indianapolis, IN promoting heart health and preventing heart related diseases. In addition, I have supported the 4URHLTH Team with health education programs and annual screenings at the Kokomo Transmission Plant, Tipton Transmission Plant, Kokomo Casting Plant, and both Indiana Transmission Plants I and II. I have attended several seminars and conferences to continue to enhance my skills in the wellness field and have earned my Certified Health Education Specialist (CHES) certification. I started as a 4URHLTH program coordinator at the Tipton Transmission Plant and have recently became the 4URHLTH wellness program coordinator at the Kokomo Casting Plant. Stellantis, the International Union. UAW, and StayWell began their relationship in 1985 when StayWell provided the wellness program at then headquarters Chrysler Center in Highland Park, and at the Toledo Machining Plant. The program was gradually added at other locations. The program saw significant growth in 1994 when, as negotiated in the Collective Bargaining Agreement, an on-site wellness program was provided at every FCA location with 500 or more employees.

StayWell was purchased by WebMD in 2020 and has slowly transitioned to one company. WebMD provides on-site delivery of comprehensive wellness programming at 16 major Stellantis facilities as well as many more receiving remote programming. Stellantis' wellness program is called 4URHLTH.

INGREDIENTS

- 2 teaspoons canola, corn, or olive oil (extra virgin preferred)
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 1 medium red or green bell pepper, chopped
- 1 medium fresh jalapeno, seeds and ribs discarded, diced (optional)
- 2 teaspoons ground cumin
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 5 cups fat-free, low-sodium chicken broth
- 11/2 pounds boneless, skinless chicken breasts, all visible fat discarded, cultinto 1-inch cubes
- 115.25 ounce can no-salt-added kidney beans, rinsed and drained
- 115.25-ounce can no-salt-added whole-kernel corn, rinsed and drained
- 1 large tomato, diced
- 1/2 cup chopped fresh cilantro and sprigs of fresh cilantro (optional)

- In a large saucepan, heat the oil over medium heat, swirling to coat the bottom. Cook the onion, bell pepper, and jalapeno for 5 minutes, or until the onion is soft and the bell pepper and jalapeno are tender-crisp. Stir in the cumin and garlic. Cook for
- Stir in the broth. Increase the heat to high and bring to a rapid simmer. Stir in the chicken. Cook for 5 minutes, or until no longer pink in the center. Stir in the beans, corn, tomato, and chopped cilantro. Cook, covered, over medium heatfor 10 minutes.
- Garnish with the remaining sprigs of cilaritro. Serve immediately.


