

We have a great program that our union negotiated for and should be utilized by its members who need help. I am always available to anyone who asks for help and have several resources that can assist them in getting the help they need. Thanks for your time and letting me represent in this process.

I want to thank the executive board and the membership for allowing me to attend the Employee Assistance Program (EAP) Conference at the Walter and May Reuther UAW Family Education Center at Black Lake. It was held on September 25th-30th. I was happy to represent 1166!

Let me explain the EAP Program. It's a worksite based program designed to assist in the identification and resolution of productivity problems associated with workers impaired by personal concerns. Some of the concerns are health, mental health, marital, family, finance, alcohol, drugs (prescription or illegal) and legal issues. Any issue a member or family of a member who s having you can speak to our EAP Rep (Craig Eden). He is here for you at anytime. It is strictly confidential!!!

Lectures and class room subjects were EAP Core, Addiction and Recovery, Mental Wellness and Early Intervention, Disaster Workers Resiliency Training, Multicultural Awareness, Legal and Ethical Practice for the EAP Representatives.

I can't say enough about the instructors. They keep the subject's interesting and they were all quite comical. Everyone participated and everyone I met was very friendly.

If you've ever been to Black Lake you know how much they feed you. So, on my down time I hiked. Just about every evening between class and dinner. Up over a bridge and through a wooded area they have trees that were donated from different countries and the Reuthers Memorial. There are bricks you can purchase in the library for UAW Members that have passed. I found the brick I purchased for a family member and Ashley Kennedy purchased one for brick for Brian West. 
